Pridemore Acts to Protect 2nd Amendments Rights:

Madison – State Representative Don Pridemore (R-Hartford) has introduced a version of a Conceal Carry Law that will easily allow law abiding citizens to carry a concealed handgun in the state of Wisconsin. The measure will require a credit card sized certificate which requires two hours of training to obtain. Once a citizen obtains the certificate, no other permit or license will be required.

In addition, no government database will be maintained. Only the private training agency may keep training records but will be discouraged from doing so. If you lose your certificate, you will have to repeat the training to maintain your right to concealed carry.

“The 2nd Amendment is a Constitutional Right and this bill upholds that Right,” said Pridemore. “Wisconsin is only one of two states that have no provision to protect our 2nd Amendment Rights. No matter how much misinformation opponents put out, the fact is that people are safer when our Right to Bear Arms is respected,” Pridemore added.

The measure is being sent out for cosponsorships this today.
